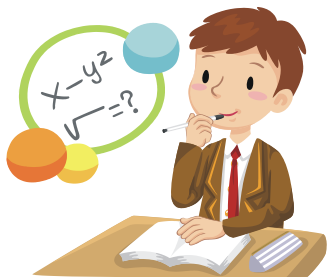

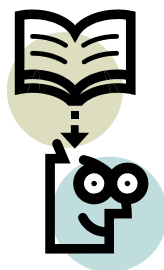
- Do you want someone to stop by your classroom to talk about the latest books? Done!

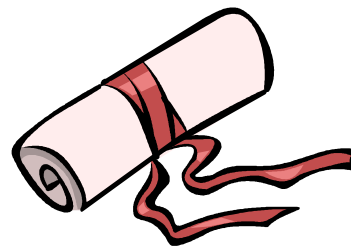
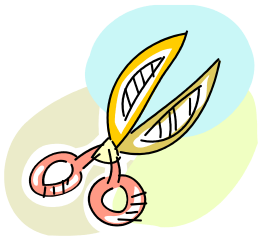

Getting a Library Card

- If you are a resident of Brown Township, bring a photo ID to Mooresville Public Library, and we'll be happy to issue one to you.
- If you are a resident of Morgan County, but not Brown Township, grab your photo ID and a recent piece of mail to stop by your local branch of the Morgan County Library to get your card. It will be valid at MPL as well.
- If you are a resident of Guilford Township, head over to Plainfield-Guilford Township Public Library with your photo ID to get your card. It will be valid at MPL as well.
- If you are a resident of Decatur, Marion County, or elsewhere, you can get an "Educator" card at MPL. Bring in your photo ID and dated proof of employment at MCSC, and we'll get you a card that can be used at MPL.

Book Requests

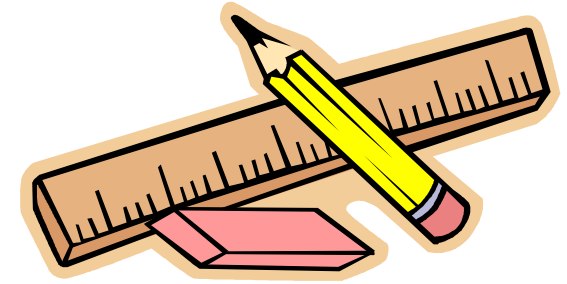
Are you doing a unit on widgets and need 30 books for silent reading? Email Jess and your books will be available for pickup at your convenience!
