

MOORESVILLE: MEDIA SPECIALIST/TEEN LIBRARIAN (FULL-TIME)

The media specialist/teen librarian is a full-time, benefits eligible position, with hours shared between two facilities: Paul Hadley Middle School (Mooresville Consolidated School Corporation) and Mooresville Public Library. This position will offer the unique opportunity to work with teens in a school library and in a public library, creating a strong partnership between both environments and facilitating quality library services to students.

The position is Monday-Friday, 7:30 AM – 4:00 PM. No evenings or weekends. During the school calendar year, the librarian will spend several hours each day at each building; during school breaks, the librarian will serve full-time at the public library.
