

I Samuel Moore of the Town of Mooresville Morgan
County Indiana do make and Publish this my last
Will and Testament

Item First, I give and desire to my beloved daughter
Margaret ^M Fogelman the wife of David Fogelman
of the Town of Mooresville Morgan County Indiana
all the land that is embraced that I now own Except that
that is laid out in Town Lots to the Town of Mooresville that
I now own, so much of East half of South West quarter
of Section thirty Six Town Fifteen Range one East
Lying West of the Rail Road South of the town of
Mooresville containing Fifty Two acres more or less

Item Second, I give and desire to my Grand
son Samuel Mc Newly a part of the North West quarter
of the South West quarter of same section and range
as above described containing Twenty Eight acres and
a half more or less running up North to the Town
line of the Town of Mooresville Indiana

Item Third I bequeath to my Grand Daughter
Mary Idia Fogelman lots one and Two in Block
Sixty five lots one and Two in Block Sixty six lots
one and Two in Block Sixty Seven West of Indiana
Street in the town of Mooresville Morgan County Indiana
and all the balance of my lands and Town Lots to be
Equally divided between that is not disposed of at my
death ^{Mary M} Fogelman my Grand daughter
and Samuel Mc Newly my Grand son to be disposed
of by them as they may deem best

Item Fourth I do hereby nominate and appoint
Margaret W Fogelman my daughter to be my
Executive of this my last Will and Testament thereby
authorizing and Empowering her to compromise
adjust release and discharge in such manner
as she may deem proper the debts and claims due
me, and I do hereby Release all former Wills by
me made, Item Fifth it is my request and a
part of this my last Will and Testament that Margaret
W Fogelman my daughter be not required to give
~~and~~ Bond or Security for her faithful performance
as my Executive to this last Will and Testament
and is fully authorized and Empowered to settle
up my Estate to the best of her judgment and discretion
