Tea Party Snacks

Cucumber Sandwiches Supplies needed:

- sandwich bread
- · cream cheese, softened
- cucumbers
 - 1. Peel and cut the cucumber into thin slices
- 2. Spread the cream cheese on two slices of bread
- 3. Place the cucumbers flat on one slice
- 4. Place the second slice of bread on top
- 5. Cut the sandwich into squares, removing crust
- 6. Repeat as necessary

Pinwheel Sandwiches Supplies needed:

- sandwich bread
- peanut butter (or any filling you like)
- rolling pin
 - wax paper

- 1. Cut the crusts off the bread
- 2. Flatten each slice between wax paper with the rolling pin
- 3. Remove the wax paper
- 4. Spread the filing over the bread
- 5. Gently roll the bread into the shape of a log
- 6. Slice the log into rounds





Tea Party Decorations

Tissue Paper Flowers Supplies needed:

- 12 layers of tissue paper in different colors scissors
- circle stencil
- green pipe cleaner
- 1. Layer the tissue paper in any order
- 2. Trace the circle stencil onto the top layer
- 3. Cut (or have an adult help) through all 12 layers it doesn't have to be perfect
- 4. Poke two small holes near the center of the circle using the scissor tip or the pipe cleaner
- 5. Thread one end of the pipe cleaner into one hole and loop in down into the second hole
- 6. Twist the short end of the pipe cleaner around the longer end this is the flower stem
- 7. Carefully scrunch the top layer of tissue at the base of the pipe cleaner
- 8. Scrunch all remaining layers, turning the flower slightly each time
- 9. The flower is done! You might want to fluff your petals or shorten your stem
