

3. Library Policy

LIBRARY POLICY (Revised July 5, 1994.)

Mooresville Public Library was established by the citizens of the community that they might have the ideas, information and entertainment provided by books and related materials.

We are in the business of selecting and preserving those materials and making them readily accessible to those who need and want them. The materials selection policy is based on two American Library Association documents: the Library Bill of Rights and Freedom to Read.

We believe in the importance of the human mind, the dignity of the individual and the right of every person to pursue the truth.

Our public relations policy is to treat each patron as an individual and a friend, entitled to the best of our particular knowledge or skills; to respect the opinions of those we serve; to inform the community fully of the operations of its library that it may appreciate and use the services it has built. The purpose of the sections to follow is to provide the guidelines necessary to operate Mooresville Public Library in a manner fair to both patrons and employees.
