

Teen and Young Adult Zone Policies

The Library Board and the staff of the Mooresville Public Library want teens (defined as students in grades 7-12) to use the library resources available to them including the Young Adult Zone (YAZ).

- Teens must follow the Library Behavior Policies and the Policies for the Use of the Internet and Other Technology. All infractions of the policies will be enforced according to MPL Policy Manual. A short reminder about these policies will be posted in the YAZ and the Computer Center.
- While all library patrons may access the materials housed in the YAZ, the chairs and benches in the YAZ are reserved for teen patrons.
- The room occupancy for the YAZ is 12 teens. Should additional teens wish to enter the YAZ when it is full, MPL will implement a fair, “first-in, first out” policy.
- Teens must be picked up within 15 minutes of closing or the Mooresville Police Department will be notified to supervise them until a parent can be found. (Adopted December 28, 2005)

No Shoes or Shirt

Patrons are not permitted to be in the building without shoes or a shirt. Remind the patron of the rule. Of course, if the patron does not have shoes or a shirt to put on, the person will have to leave at once. ONE WARNING AND OUT.

Feet on Tables and Chairs

Placing feet, whether bare or shod, on tables and chairs is prohibited. A staff member should remind the patron of the rule. ONE WARNING AND OUT.
