Mooresville Public Library Amnesty/ Food for Fines Board Resolution

June 4, 2012

The Mooresville Public Library, on selected dates, will encourage and allow patrons to pay fines for overdue library materials by donating non-perishable food items, including paper products, personal hygiene products, and cleaning products. Collection will take place only at the Mooresville Public Library in Mooresville, Indiana, for the benefit of local food pantry. All donated items shall not be damaged or expired.

Donations will be accepted only from Mooresville Public Library patrons, to pay fines for materials borrowed from the Mooresville Public Library only. This excludes items damaged or lost by patrons. Donated items shall be valued as follows:

- Non-perishable food items will be worth 50 cents each.
- Packaged and un-tampered paper products, personal hygiene, and cleaning products will be worth \$1 each.

This policy does not apply to fines incurred for materials borrowed by Mooresville Public Library patrons from other libraries in the Evergreen Consortium Library system, or to fines incurred for materials borrowed from the Mooresville Public Library by patrons of other libraries in the Evergreen Consortium Library system, or to fines or collection fees for Mooresville Public Library accounts that have been turned over to Unique Management for collections.
