

## D. ILLEGAL BEHAVIOR

Some behavior is illegal and should be handled in a different manner. Examples of illegal behavior follow:

**Assault** Intentionally or by reckless conduct causes injury to another person.

**Criminal mischief** Intentionally damages the property of another (including vandalism and mutilation of library materials.)

**Drunk and/or disorderly conduct** Causes public inconvenience by fighting, unreasonable noises, abusive or obscene language or gestures, threatening behavior, or hazardous or physically offensive behavior.

**Harassment** Threatens or annoys another person by physical contact or abusive or obscene language, or follows a person in or about a public place.

**Public lewdness** Intentionally exposes the private or intimate parts of the body in a lewd manner in a public place.

**Theft (larceny)** Wrongfully takes, obtains or withholds the property of another.

**Trespass** Knowingly enters or remains unlawfully in or upon the premises.

If you witness illegal behavior, report it immediately to the librarian in charge, who will notify the police, when necessary.
