D. ILLEGAL BEHAVIOR

Some behavior is illegal and should be handled in a different manner. Examples of illegal behavior follow:

Assault Intentionally or by reckless conduct causes injury to another person.

Criminal mischief
Intentionally damages the property of another (including vandalism and

mutilation of library materials.)

Drunk and/or Causes public inconvenience by fighting, unreasonable noises, abusive **disorderly conduct** or obscene language or gestures, threatening behavior, or hazardous or

physically offensive behavior.

Harassment Threatens or annoys another person by physical contact or abusive or

obscene language, or follows a person in or about a public place.

Public lewdness Intentionally exposes the private or intimate parts of the body in a lewd

manner in a public place.

Theft (larceny) Wrongfully takes, obtains or withholds the property of another.

Trespass Knowingly enters or remains unlawfully in or upon the premises.

If you witness illegal behavior, report it immediately to the librarian in charge, who will notify the police, when necessary.
