

# OUR RESPONSE

**March 16, 2020:** Mooresville Public Library closes to the public to help in "flattening the curve"

- WiFi signal boosted for parking lot connection
- Digital resources expanded
- Library cards issued by mail for access to e-Resources

**May 16, 2020:** Library opens for curbside service only

- Curbside pickup of holds and curbside document services
- 72 Hour quarantining of returned items
- Instructional videos on using digital resources
- Facebook Live Storytimes
- Teen Discord server

**June 8, 2020:** Library re-opens to the public for limited hours

- Touchless self-checks
- Plastic screens at all service desks
- Limited capacity and masks required for all visitors and staff
- Virtual Summer Reading Program
- Curbside service continues as an option

**August 1, 2020:** Library returns to regular hours

- Curbside made a permanent option for patrons
- Regular virtual programs for all age groups

**January 13, 2021:** Library dedicates one computer station for patrons to schedule and register for vaccine appointments

- Staff trained to assist people in scheduling appointments
