

A YEAR OF CORONAVIRUS

December 31, 2019: Multiple cases of "viral pneumonia" in Wuhan China reported to WHO (World Health Organization)

January 11, 2020: Chinese media reports the first death from the novel coronavirus

January 13, 2020: First reported case of the novel coronavirus outside of China (Thailand)

January 20, 2020: First confirmed case in the United States

February 11, 2020: The disease caused by the novel coronavirus is named COVID-19

February 29, 2020: CDC and Washington State report first deaths in United States from COVID-19

March 6, 2020: First case confirmed in Indiana

March 11, 2020: WHO declares the COVID-19 outbreak to be a pandemic

March 16, 2020: First death in Indiana

April 1, 2020: 163,199 confirmed cases and 2850 deaths in the United States

May 1, 2020: 1,035,353 confirmed cases and 60,632 deaths in the United States

May 29, 2020: 100,034 deaths in the United States

September 25, 2020: 200,725 deaths in the United States

December 11, 2020: FDA issues first emergency use authorization of a COVID-19 vaccine.

December 14, 2020: First vaccine doses arrive in Indiana

December 17, 2020: 301,536 deaths in the United States

January 22, 2021: 402,803 deaths in the United States

March 1, 2021: 513,092 deaths in the United States, 2,532,756 deaths worldwide. 12,142 deaths in Indiana. 565,722 fully vaccinated individuals in Indiana.
