MOORESVILLE HIGH SCHOOL.

This Institution is under the care of a Board of Trustees, called the "MOORESVILLE HIGH SCHOOL ASSOCIATION," and is under the immediate superintendence of a Board of Managers elected by the Trustees from their number, who are vested with authority to exercise such control over the school and all its appendages as they may find necessary to preserve good order and promote the interests of the Institution.

ADMISSION.

Students are desired to enter the School at the beginning of the session, but they may enter at any time, and after the first and the second week (for which no deduction will be made) they will be charged, according to the prescribed rates, from the time of entry to the end of the term.

The School has connected with it a Primary Department for the admission of pupils of a lower grade than originally contemplated; but it is not the design to admit such as cannot read with some degree of readiness in a Third Reader.

Applications should be made early to Joseph Pool, Secretary of the Board, as pupils will obtain precedence in the order in which application and payment are made.

SESSIONS AND PRICES.

The Scholastic Year will consist of thirty-seven weeks, divided into three Terms, as follows:

The first Term will consist of thirteen weeks, beginning ninth month, 25th, and closing twelfth month, 22d, 1865. Tuition in the Higher Department, \$8.75; Primary, \$5.50.

The second term will consist of ten weeks, beginning first month, 1st, and closing third month, 9th, 1866. Tuition in the Higher Department, \$6.75; Primary, \$4.25.

The third Term will consist of fourteen weeks, beginning third month, 19th, and closing sixth month, 22d, 1866. Tuition in the Higher Department, \$9.50; Primary, \$6.00.
