
STUDENT COUNCIL







Although the boys put their all into each sport, this year Mooresville seemed to shine especially in Basketball and Track.


The Basketball team, after a 50-50 season, lasted until the final game of the sectionals, to lose by only 4 points to their old rival, Martinsville.
