

Banner Flour Mill, East High Street, Mooresville, IN (Built in 1868)

Banner Flour Mill was built in 1868 by S. M. Rooker and David Fogleman. During the first year of business, 14,000 bushels of wheat were carried to the third floor by a hand-turned windlass. Farm Bureau Co-op purchased the mill in 1944 and operated until the building was razed in 1986. (Top photo circa 1870s; bottom photo circa 1890s).
