Flash From Your Past Historical Flash Card Series – Waverly

In 1850 a wood frame, white school house was constructed on the corner of the original Whetzel plat of Waverly. The school served the community for 65 years. In 1915, a two-story brick building was erected atop Waverly Hill, which was known as the District One School. This was partially burned on March 13, 1932, but it was rebuilt. In 1956 Harrison Township schools became part of Mooresville Consolidated School Corporation. A new elementary school was constructed in 1965, and the old school was demolished in 1966.
