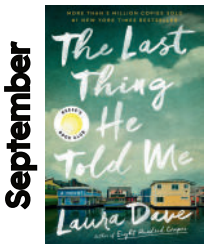

This book club meets the second Thursday of each month at 1 PM.

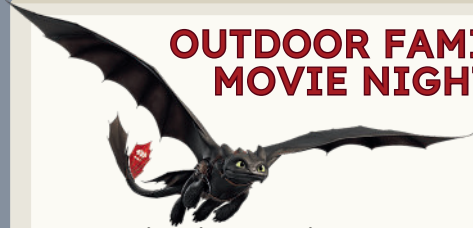

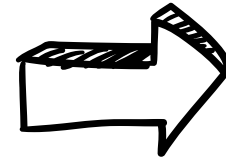
TEEN LIBRARY COUNCIL MEETINGS
