

Mooresville Public Library
FOL Board Meeting Minutes
September 22, 2025

Call meeting to order: A quorum being present, the regular meeting of the Friends of the Library of the Mooresville Public Library Board was called to order at 5:02 PM in the Indiana Room of the Mooresville Public Library by President, **Sonja Williams**.

Old Business:

- Of the FOL Board members present, only Sonja Williams will attend the Professional Development Day lunch and tour on Monday, October 13, 2025. Sandra will reach out to April Kolb to find out if she is attending.



- Sandra Osborn provided an update on the elevator, explaining why the inspector required it to be shut down. The first proposal to address the issue was turned down. The construction team is working with the elevator company on another solution.
- Sonja Williams provided an update on the additional space made available to the FOL to store UBR back stock in the basement. A brief discussion was held regarding various sections of the UBR Guidelines and changes that could be made to them.
- Update on Renovation. Sandra Osborn reported that the renovation is ongoing in the Youth Services area with a lot of progress being made. They are close to being finished, and books are being moved back into the area. The Youth Services area will be open to the public by the end of October. The Teen area can't be finished until the new Server Room in the basement is finished. Until that time, the Teen area will be used as a staging area for other parts of the project. Once Youth Services is out of the Community Room, the Circulation Desk will be moved to the Community Room. The FOL book sales will also be moved to the Community Room, and will be conducted from a few carts in the Community Room. After the Circulation Desk area is complete, the remaining sections of the library will move quickly as they are mostly limited to new carpet and paint. The hope is that the entire project will be completed in January.

New Business:

Financial Requests:

- As the Banned Book Week bookmarks have been purchased and Victoria Hillis has completed the paperwork for her certification, Sandra Osborn requested a check for \$96.08 to reimburse the Library for these expenses. Both of these financial requests were approved at the August meeting.

Other New Business

- Sonja Williams shared some comments about the additions made to the UBR pricing sheet. A brief discussion ensued. She also reminded everyone that the used book prices will go back to pre-COVID pricing (\$1 hardbacks and \$0.50 paperbacks) at that time and the honor box payment option and \$5 for a bag of books will be eliminated.
- Sonja Williams shared some comments about the development of the UBR donation information. A brief discussion was had regarding its purpose and placement and changes to the document.
- Sonja Williams began a discussion about the difficulty of copying the entire existing logo. All agreed that clearly referencing the Mooresville Public Library would be a plus. Discussion ensued about the potential updated logos presented. **Kristi Thompson** motioned the open book logo be adopted with the addition of a circle around the entire logo. **Dawn Wright** seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
- Sandra Osborn gave a tour of the construction progress in the Youth Services and Teen area after the meeting.
